

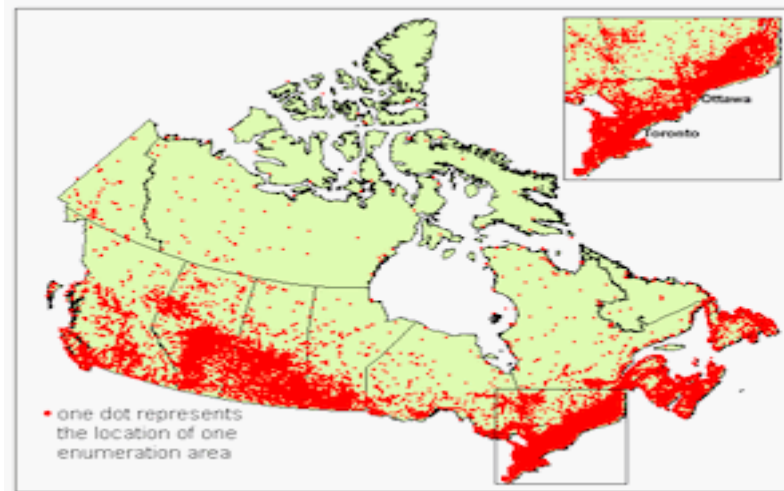

Despite its vast size, Canada has a relatively small population of 30 million.



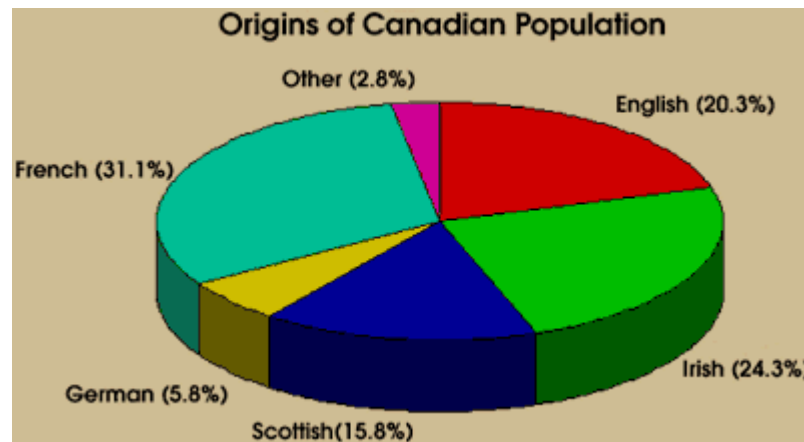
